Children for Health (CfH) is seeking an additional Trustee with experience in funding, partnerships, and strategic networks to join its Board at an important moment of organisational transition and growth.

Children for Health is a UK-registered global charity that strengthens children's health literacy and agency, enabling children to contribute meaningfully to the health and wellbeing of their families, communities, and wider systems. With over 14 years of experience and reach across more than 190 countries, CfH is evolving from an education tools model towards broader public health impact, research, and systems influence, including emerging work at the intersection of child health, climate, and community resilience.

About the role

This Trustee role focuses on strategic income generation, partnerships, and external positioning at Board level.

Working alongside fellow Trustees and the Chief Executive, the postholder will contribute insight and guidance on funding pathways, donor landscapes, partnerships, and networks, helping ensure CfH is well-positioned for sustainable growth. This is a governance and advisory role, not an operational fundraising position.

Key responsibilities

- Contribute to Board level discussions on funding strategy, income diversification, and long-term sustainability
- Provide insight into philanthropic, institutional, corporate, or innovative funding models
- Support the organisation's external positioning and credibility with funders and partners
- Use professional networks strategically to advise on opportunities, introductions, and partnerships
- Act as an ambassador for Children for Health, championing its mission and participatory ethos
- Contribute fully to the collective responsibilities of the Board of Trustees

Who we are looking for

Essential:

- Senior-level experience in funding, partnerships, philanthropy, or related fields
- Strong understanding of strategic funding and income generation
- Confidence operating within complex professional networks
- Ability to contribute at Board level
- Commitment to the mission and values of Children for Health

Desirable:

- Trustee, non-executive, or governance experience
- Familiarity with trusts and foundations, institutional donors, or corporate partnerships
- Experience with international or global health organisations
- Cultural or contextual insight relevant to South Asia or diaspora communities

Time commitment

- Approximately 4–6 Board meetings per year (primarily remote)
- Occasional additional engagement for strategic discussions or introductions
- Initial term of three years, renewable once
