With over 14 years of experience and reach across more than 190 countries, CfH is evolving from an education tools model towards broader public health impact, research, and systems influence.

### **About the role**

The Treasurer is a Trustee of the charity and plays a key role in overseeing the financial health, sustainability, and integrity of Children for Health.

Working closely with the Board of Trustees and the Chief Executive, the Treasurer provides strategic financial oversight and advice, helping ensure that resources are managed responsibly and aligned with the organisation's mission and long-term strategy.

This is a governance and strategic role, not an operational finance position.

### **Key responsibilities**

- Lead the Board's oversight of financial management, controls, and risk
- Support strategic financial planning, budgeting, and forecasting
- Present financial information to the Board in a clear and accessible way
- Ensure compliance with charity finance, reporting, and regulatory requirements
- Contribute to wider Board discussions on strategy, growth, and partnerships
- Act as an ambassador for CfH where appropriate
